

Daily Challenge Day 20 Boat Art

James Dodds is a British artist. His paintings and prints are inspired by boats and boat building. After being apprenticed as a shipwright in Maldon, Essex, he studied at Colchester School of Art, Chelsea School of Art and the Royal College of Art.



Have a go at using lollipop sticks or twigs to recreate planks of wood to make a boat picture in the same way as this lighthouse.



Try using paint or crayons to create pictures of boats.

You might want to have a go at this style of art below. James Dodds uses a linocut technique but you could have a go at drawing an island in this way using pencils or pens. This is of West Mersea, Essex. Notice the focus on lines.

You could use black pen or pencil.

1. Draw an outline of your island.
2. Add houses and buildings.
3. Add boats and seashore.
